**Stay in a 1950 Airstream**: One of the nine suites here. 25-feet of pool-adjacent, lovingly restored aluminum awaiting you and a date. If it's you and friends, you'll want the Billiards Suite, which comes with a pool table, wet bar and curated vinyl for a Shinola record player.
